Must be 12 years and older. If person under instruction is between 12 and 18 years of age written consent of parent or guardian, must co-sign this declaration and their attendance is required.

Prohibited Persons Definition

The Firearms Act 1996 (Vic) Section 3, defines automatic restrictions such as:

- Guilty of a criminal offence in the last 12 months
- Imprisoned in the last 5 years
- Subject to a full intervention order
- Subject to a Firearms Prohibition Order
- Revoked or rejected firearms license
- Other prohibiting offences or conditions defined within the Act
